Whether you're trying yoga for the first time or are a seasoned yogi, this three-week session is just right for you! **Registration is required for each week – space is limited.**

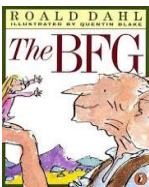


MAD Science of Iowa *(Grades 2 & Up)*
