- AGE:** Open to GIRLS in 5th, 6th, 7th or 8th grade. Skill levels are designed for anyone that would like to play.
- COACHES:** Will include parent volunteers, HS volleyball players and former players.
- TEAMS:** Teams will consist of ten players or less with 1-2 coaches per team.
- LOCATION:** All practices will be held at Glacier Creek Middle School. Home games will be at the Middle School. Away games will be at Mount Horeb, Fitchburg or Verona.
- SCHEDULE:** Days for practices and tournaments will be Sunday. Practices will begin in January and tournaments will begin on February 20th.
- TOURNAMENTS:** Home tournaments will be held at Glacier Creek Middle School. Away tournaments will be at Mount Horeb, Fitchburg or Verona. Tournaments will be played on February 20th, February 26th, March 6th, March 13th and March 20th. Times for the tournaments will be around 12:30-3:30pm depending on number of teams. Warm-ups will run from 12:00-12:27pm.
- COST:** \$60.00 per player includes: shirt, practices and tournament play.
