What's New?

Staff, students and parents visited Glacier Creek on Tuesday for an information/registration day and open house. The ADA path to the amphitheater has been completed, trees have been planted, and seeding is in place at the amphitheater. The final coat of asphalt has been installed and striped in all areas excluding the main parking lot.
