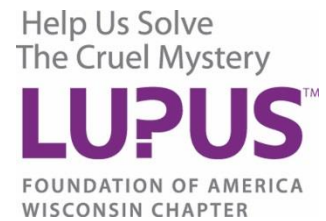


VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY

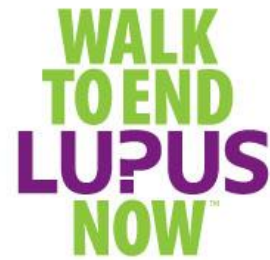
