What is a Pack? A group of scouts (boys and girls!) who are in Kindergarten-5th grade.

What is a Den? A group of scouts determined by their grade. All the dens together make up a pack.

- Lion Den: Kindergarten
- Tiger Den: 1st Grade
- Wolf Den: 2nd Grade
- Bear Den: 3rd Grade
- Webelos: 4th Grade
- Arrow of Light: 5th Grade

When does our Pack meet? During the pandemic, our Pack will not be able to meet, but we hope to begin meetings once it is safe. Typically, scouts and a parent/guardian attend our Pack meetings on the first Thursdays of the month from 6:30-7:30 P.M. at West Middleton Lutheran Church.

When would my den meet? During the pandemic, small group Dens will likely meet more frequently- two meetings per month at the day and time set up by the Den Leader. Parents are required to attend with their child this year. Den activities will be held either outdoors-wearing masks- or via zoom calls when appropriate.

What are some activities we have planned for this year? Camping at Devil's Lake State Park, the Pinewood Derby, service projects, hiking, and much more!

Does it cost anything to join Cub Scouts?

Yes, but we are reducing yearly dues this year to \$100 because our group outings will likely be more minimal. That fee covers registration, den books, derby car kits, camping trips, and the purchase of earned adventure loops and pins. We are happy to work with families in need of financial assistance.

What can I do to help? We ask parents to get involved in small groups that organize and plan activities such as our Pinewood Derby, camping and outdoor activities, our Blue and Gold dinner, our end of the year picnic, and help organize service projects. We have committee positions that help our pack run smoothly, such as cubmaster, secretary, membership chair, outdoor committee, pinewood derby committee, and more. All the dens are led by parent volunteers, so leading a den or co-leading a den is another volunteer option. Being part of a pack is not just for the scouts, but a way for parents to be involved in their child's scouting experience as well.
