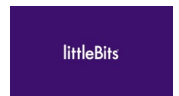
Apprenticed STEM Club:

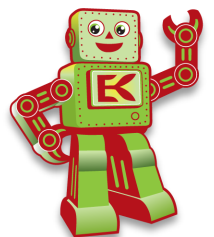
