



Hello District families,

We have more information about when students and families will be able to return to schools to collect their personal belongings and medicines, and also drop off materials.

District staff will spend the next two weeks collecting student belongings from classrooms and lockers and putting the items in individually marked bags. Students and their families will be assigned dates based on a child's last name when they can come to their school to pick up the belongings. The earliest pickup and drop off will begin is Tuesday, June 9. There will also be additional dates when families can get the items if the initial date doesn't work out.

Families may only pick up items for their children. High school students may only pick up their items.

We ask that you place a sheet of paper with the name of any students in your family whose materials you are picking up along with their grade, and the classroom teacher, if applicable. Please also note if you need to pick up any medicines. Families will remain in their vehicles, while a staff member retrieves the items. Please open the trunk or back of your vehicle so the items can be placed there. We strongly suggest you leave the items in your vehicle for 72 hours before removing them.

We are still waiting for yearbooks to be delivered from the printer, but if they are available they will also be distributed to families at this time if you have ordered and paid for one.

If you are returning textbooks, library books, music instruments or Chromebooks, please put them in individual, clear plastic bags with your child's name on each bag and place them in your trunk or the back of your vehicle. Staff will take the items at the same time they drop off your child's belongings.

Please also include their user name and street address on the plastic bag with the Chromebook. Please also include the power cord and mouse with the Chromebook if you were assigned one of those items.

Please look for a communication from the school your child attends with more information.
