

**Feb. 1, 2017 - Meeting Minutes**

**1. CALL TO ORDER SIXTH MEETING AT 6:30 P.M.**

**2. TOUR OF WEST MIDDLETON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

Members were given a 30-minute tour of the school led by Principal Katrina Krych and Director of Special Education Cindy Malcheski. Members visited the kindergarten wing, which was added about a decade ago. They also saw areas that will likely need to be converted into classrooms starting next year. Krych also told them the gymnasium is too small to hold all-school assemblies.

**3. SMALL GROUP CLUSTERING & SHAREOUT**

Members were assigned to one of three groups and spent 45 minutes discussing ways to address enrollment challenges at the elementary, middle and high school level. District officials Lori Ames and Sherri Cyra facilitated two of the groups, while Park principal and FPC member Monica Schommer facilitated the third.

The groups then shared out their ideas at all three levels. Some common themes included redrawing boundary lines, adding on at Park Elementary, rebuilding or relocating West Middleton, building at least one elementary school at Pope Farm Conservancy and expanding Glacier Creek.
