What's New?

School board and administration members gathered on Thursday for a stone setting ceremony and media day – participants installed stone on the main entrance columns. Food service equipment is being installed in the kitchen and servery. Terrazzo floor installation is continuing near the administration offices, and the site is being prepared for the installation of vinyl flooring in the 5th grade wing. Drywall installation, taping, and painting is continuing in the 6th, 7th and 8th grade wing.

- Installation of curtain wall and glass in 6th, 7th and 8th grade wing – Areas A & B
- Geothermal trenching and system tie-in is continuing – Site
- Site grading behind the 6th, 7th and 8th grade wing - Site

- Finishing geothermal trenching and system tie-in – Site
- Drywall installation in the west portion of the 7th grade wing – Area A
