What's New?

Even with the recent wet weather, exterior work is continuing. Concrete curb at the east end of the site has been completed and this area is ready for sidewalks. Exterior light poles have been installed, and exterior painting is continuing. Inside the building, the final punch list for the front office and administration area has been completed. Final touches are being taken care of in the 5th grade wing in preparation for the final punch list.
